- Measurement: Height and Width, Perimeter and Area
- Geometry: Properties of Shape

In Science, we are learning about *Forces and Magnets*. The children will be learning about push and pull, friction and magnetic and non-magnetic materials. We will continue to focus on developing scientific enquiry skills, such as making predictions, carrying out simple tests and recording observations made.

In Humanities, the children will be learning about significant individuals throughout history. We will be delving into Shakespeare, learning about the Civil Rights Movement, the Suffragettes and war spies. Where possible, we will link these topics with English and Maths to think about how Light and Sound support these celebrations.

The children will continue to take part in social skills sessions to develop their understanding and awareness of the world we live in. We will also be implementing individual learning sessions to target specific needs.
